

ISES 2022 Conference Award Application

The ISES 2022 Annual Meeting will be inclusive to scientists from around the world. To further support students and new researchers, scientists from developing countries*, and/or those who are experiencing extreme financial hardship due to the pandemic, ISES has established the ISES 2022 Conference Award.

* Countries classified as developing countries or regions for this purpose are those whose economies are listed by the World Bank as “Low Income,” “Lower Middle Income,” or “Upper Middle Income” in the World Development Report. A list of countries not considered as “Developing Countries or Regions” can be found at the end of this application form.

Awards will include a monetary amount to be applied to meeting registrations, and a one-year ISES membership. In addition, for low-income countries applicants, additional funds may be available to cover some parts of the travel expense. Selection criteria include quality of abstract, financial need, and interest, commitment, and contributions to exposure science.
